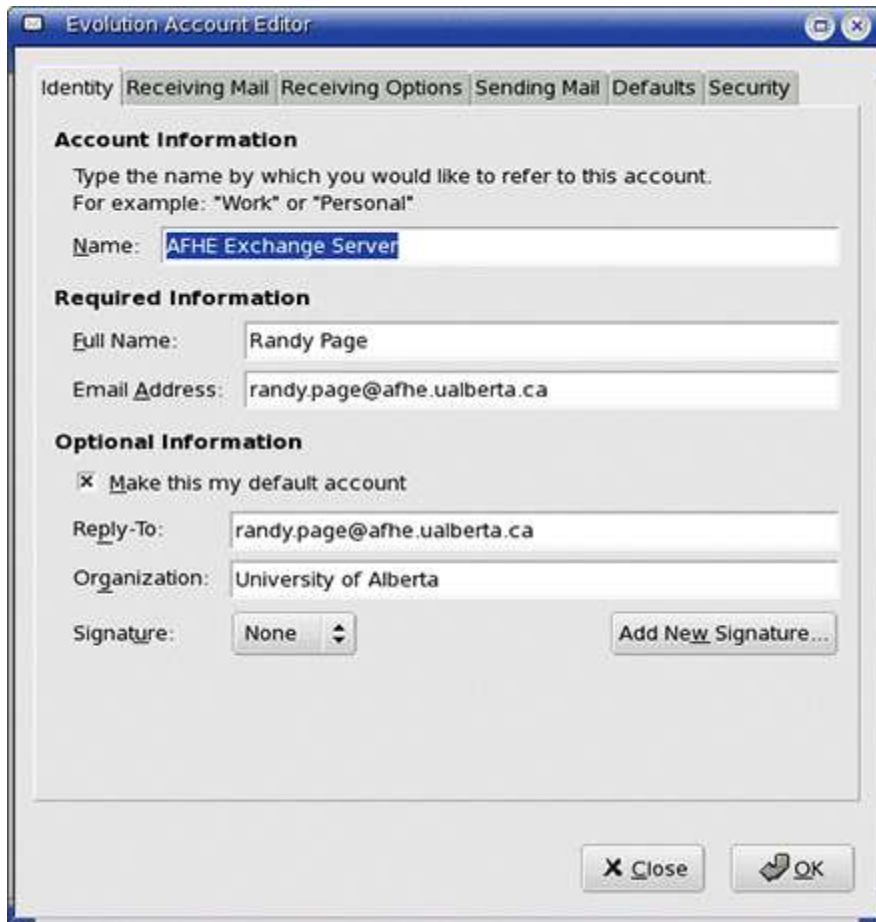


## Using Ximian Evolution with Microsoft Exchange 2003

The first step in installing Evolution with exchange functionality is to ensure that you have the Evolution-exchange package installed for your distro. See the documentation for your distributions package management system for this.

Go to Tools --> Settings. Click the “Add” button.





The Account Editor will then open. Fill in the fields on all tabs as shown below, substituting my information with yours. Don't worry about the security tab at this time.

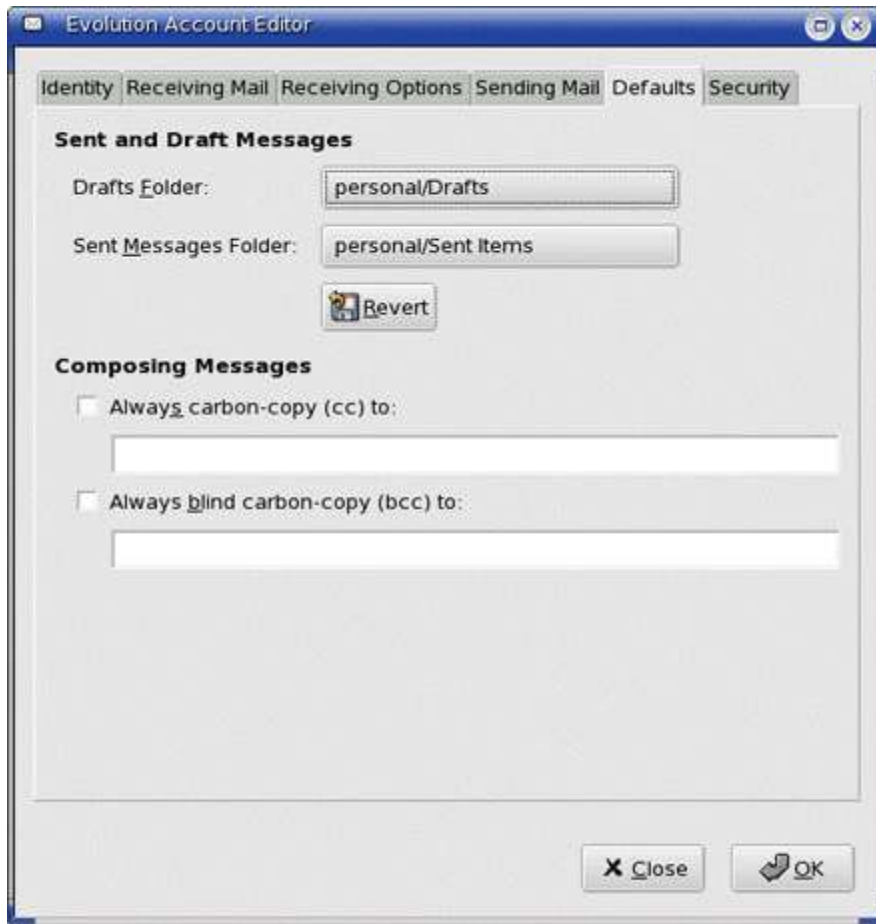
Apply filters to new messages in Inbox on this server
